With the extended Spring Break beginning next week. The RE-1 Valley Food Service Dept. will be offering free meals to all students on the days that the students would have returned to school from Spring Break.

Beginning on TUESDAY MARCH 24TH- FRIDAY MARCH 27TH. We will be preparing meals at Sterling High School and at Caliche School. (The meals in the Caliche community will be served at two different sites, listed below, not at the school itself.) This will be a drive up distribution for all students in the area, not just RE-1 Valley students ages 0-18. It is free for all children in that age group. You are allowed one bag per child. You will just tell staff how many kids you need bags for and they will give you that number of bags. We do not want people getting out of their vehicles to get meals or standing line to get a bag. No eating meals on site, they must be taken away from the distribution site. We are using an abundance of caution with our staff and having as little contact with the public as possible. They will have gloves on and will have minimal contact with people coming to get meals. The bags will contain a full lunch,(sandwich, fruit and or veggies & milk) and two snack items. All FREE!

Distribution sites and times:

STERLING HIGH SCHOOL: Serving will begin at 11:00 and end at 12:00pm The meals will be handed out on the south side of the building on Broadway St. Please pull into the lot on the WEST end near the football field, pull up to the curb and a staff member will give you your meal bags, Please do NOT get out of your vehicle, someone will come to you. Once you get your meal bags exit the lot on the East end back onto Broadway St. No meals are to be eating on site, they are Grab and Go to avoid any large group of people in one area.

CALICHE: Serving will be from 11:30 am to 12:00 pm from the Crook Town Hall and Iliff Community Center. There will be a staff member distributing the meal bags from their vehicles, not from the inside the building. Again, please stay in your vehicle and drive up and get your meal bag.

At this time we are doing meals for this week only, if the closure is extended longer, then we will go from there at that time. Please be patient if you have to wait a few minutes to get a meal.

We are in close contact with the Health Dept. and following all the safety guidelines to keep you and our staff as safe as possible.

Please check the schools website and this site often for updates as we get them.
