

Patient COVID Vaccine Scheduling Information

- Patient's Age 65-69 are now being offered the vaccine.
 - Teachers not in this age bracket should work with their employer and the NE Colorado Health Department to receive their vaccine. Wal-Mart Pharmacy is also offering vaccines to teachers.
 - Patients Age 70+ continue to be offered the vaccine. All patients in this age bracket have received My Health Connection Invites or phone calls from the COVID Hotline to schedule with UHealth.
 - UHealth facilities administering vaccines are following the State of Colorado Department of Health guidelines for who should be vaccinated and when. High risk has not been a determinate for moving patients up in the process at this time.
 - Sterling Primary Care is not currently offering the vaccine due to our inability to store the vaccine at the temperature it must be kept at. This may change in the future when other manufacturers vaccines become available to the public.
1. **UHealth** – Patients with My Health Connection (MHC) will receive a total of 3 invites (48 hours to schedule with each at this time.) If you don't have a MHC account, you will receive a call (10 attempts) with an invite to schedule. Site locations closest to Sterling: UHealth Greeley Hospital, Medical Center of the Rockies in Loveland (MCR), Poudre Valley Hospital in Fort Collins (PVH);

 2. **Salud** – Go to www.saludclinic.org and visit the COVID Vaccine link to schedule. (**They are no longer scheduling via phone.**) Information after receiving the vaccine will be sent to the PCP's office via CIIS. Please visit Salud's website for more information:

 3. **Banner Family Care Clinic** – **Effective 1/29/2021**, patients can now call the Banner Family Care Clinic directly to schedule 970-521-3223. No longer contacting patients from a waitlist.
 4. **Northeast Colorado Health Department** – Please check their website often for updates and announcements for vaccine dates: www.nchd.org; They are requesting that you register for the vaccine online at www.nchd.org/covidvaxlink. Registration will close for all clinics at 4 pm the day before the clinic is scheduled or when all slots have been filled (whichever comes first) ***Please do not call them to schedule. Mass advertising for upcoming clinics will be coming soon via newspaper, radio and social media.***
 5. **Haxtun Hospital** – Please call (970) 774-6123, press option #4, leave your name and phone number and they will contact you when a vaccine becomes available. (Address – 235 West Fletcher, Haxtun, CO 80731)
 6. **Wal-Mart Pharmacy** – **Effective 2/11/2021**, patients can now receive their COVID vaccine at Wal-Mart Pharmacy. Go to www.Walmart.com/COVIDvaccine from your phone or desktop computer. Following the prompts to schedule your vaccine. They are accepting walk-ins for patients 65+ and teachers when supplies are available. Please contact them directly for availability.
